Though Ken's obsession with all things tech makes him a suspect too—maybe he thought he could "improve" Matthew's phone setup. Shashika is all about efficiency, so if she took it, she probably thought she could make Matthew's workday more productive. Rosemary? She spends enough time with Matthew—maybe she wanted some extra insight into his schedule.
